Algoma Presbytery Executive met at 12 noon on Thursday, June 24, 2010 at St. Andrew's United Church, Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario. The meeting was led by Chair Rev. Nancy Ferguson and a quorum was present.

OPENING: At 12:10 p.m., Chair Nancy Ferguson called the meeting to order, and opened with prayer.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: With the addition of two items under "New Business" (reports on the Kempton Hewitt event and visits by overseas personnel), the agenda was adopted as amended.

PREVIOUS MINUTES: Moved, seconded and <u>carried</u> that the Presbytery Executive minutes of March 18 and May 6, 2010 be approved.

CORRESPONDENCE:

- Moved, seconded and <u>carried</u> that Algoma Presbytery Executive accepts, with regret and thanks for over ten years' service, Harry Stewart's resignation from Presbytery and Presbytery Executive as Member-at-Large.
- Moved, seconded and <u>carried</u> that Algoma Presbytery Executive accepts with gratitude Harry Stewart's offer to continue as Presbytery Webmaster, and asks him to investigate the "Content Management System" and report back to the Executive before any changes are made.

Pastoral Relations: Leone Hamilton

Betty Pretty and Leone Hamilton are serving on the Joint Needs Assessment Committee for Iron Bridge. Helen Smith will be the Acting Supervisor of the Rydal Bank Pastoral Charge for July and August. Rev. Jan Schenell will be on medical leave for the month of July.

The Chair of the Executive read aloud the June 15 covering letter of the revised report from the Pastoral Relations Committee regarding the Blind River Pastoral Charge. After discussion, it was moved, seconded and <u>carried</u> that the Algoma Presbytery Executive receive the revised Pastoral Relations Consultation Team report on Blind River from the Pastoral Relations Committee dated June 15 for information.

Finance and Administration: Fred Bright

In the absence of Finance Chair Fred Bright and Treasurer Phil Miller, Nancy Ferguson reported that legal fees relating to Blind River have reached \$9,858.91 to date with a deductible of \$7,500. A card and cheque are being Expressposted to Peter Bishop. A statement of our expenses with copies of cheques and bills will be submitted to the National Office. Heather McLean reported that she had had an e-mail from Lois Matton requesting information about the Blind River appeal; it was suggested that Heather refer the questions to Susan Jones and ADP.

PLANNING TASKS

Racial Justice Training Workshop: This training is to be completed in 2010. Space has tentatively been booked at St. Andrew's United Church, Sault Ste. Marie.

Agenda for September Presbytery Meeting/Planning Discussion: Committee Chairs were reminded to let all their group members know whether or not their Committee is meeting, and then alert the Presbytery Secretary so that space can be booked. The proposed agenda for September was reviewed and amended slightly, with an earlier start to include time for a presentation by London Conference President Maya Landell. Nancy Ferguson will issue an invitation to Maya to attend.

NEW BUSINESS

Huntington University Report: Rev. Betty Pretty reported that Huntington is celebrating its 50th anniversary this year. It was suggested that she put up a display and speak to the Presbytery in November.

KAIROS Request – **Waterloo Presbytery:** This was referred to the Outreach Committee, which was asked to review the material and bring a report to the September meeting of Presbytery.

Rev. Kempton Hewitt Workshop: To date, eight people have registered for the July 8 event. Lunch will be catered and delivered to Desbarats United Church where the workshop is being held. A request was made for the use of the Presbytery projector.

Overseas Personnel: The dates were reviewed for Karen and Bill Butt's visit to Algoma; it was suggested that the Witmers be invited to speak to the Presbytery in November.
